Animal Sciences (B.S.)

Train in both basic and applied agricultural systems, with an emphasis on production in the tropics. Learn about proper care/welfare and management of pets and companion animals (including horses), farm livestock, marine mammals, exotic wildlife, and/ or zoo animals. Learn about animal nutrition, genetics, and breeding.

Prepare for veterinary, medical, or pharmacy school or graduate study in the sciences.
