TEN COMMANDMENTS OF PRUNING TREES

- 1. Thou Shalt Not prune off branch collars.
- 2. Thou Shalt Not <u>prune during periods of low energy</u> <u>reserves (stress periods).</u>
- 3. Thou Shalt Not prune during leaf flushes.
- 4. Thou Shalt Not prune during fruit growth periods.
- 5. Thou Shalt Not <u>allow codominant stems</u>.
- 6. Thou Shalt Not prune more than a third of the tree at any one time.
- 7. Thou Shalt Not head back except in special cases.
- 8. Thou Shalt Not use pruning paints or seals over cut surfaces or wounds.
- 9. Thou Shalt Not <u>cut off large branches in one</u> <u>downward stroke.</u>
- 10. Thou Shalt Not <u>cut downward into small branch</u> <u>crotches.</u>
