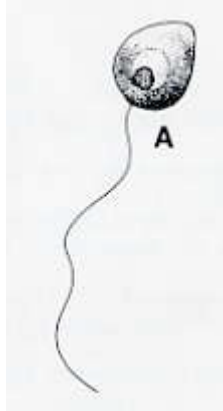




*Rhizophidium* sp. attached to *Criconemoides* sp. forms zoosporangia external to the body of the host (picture is courtesy of Esser).
