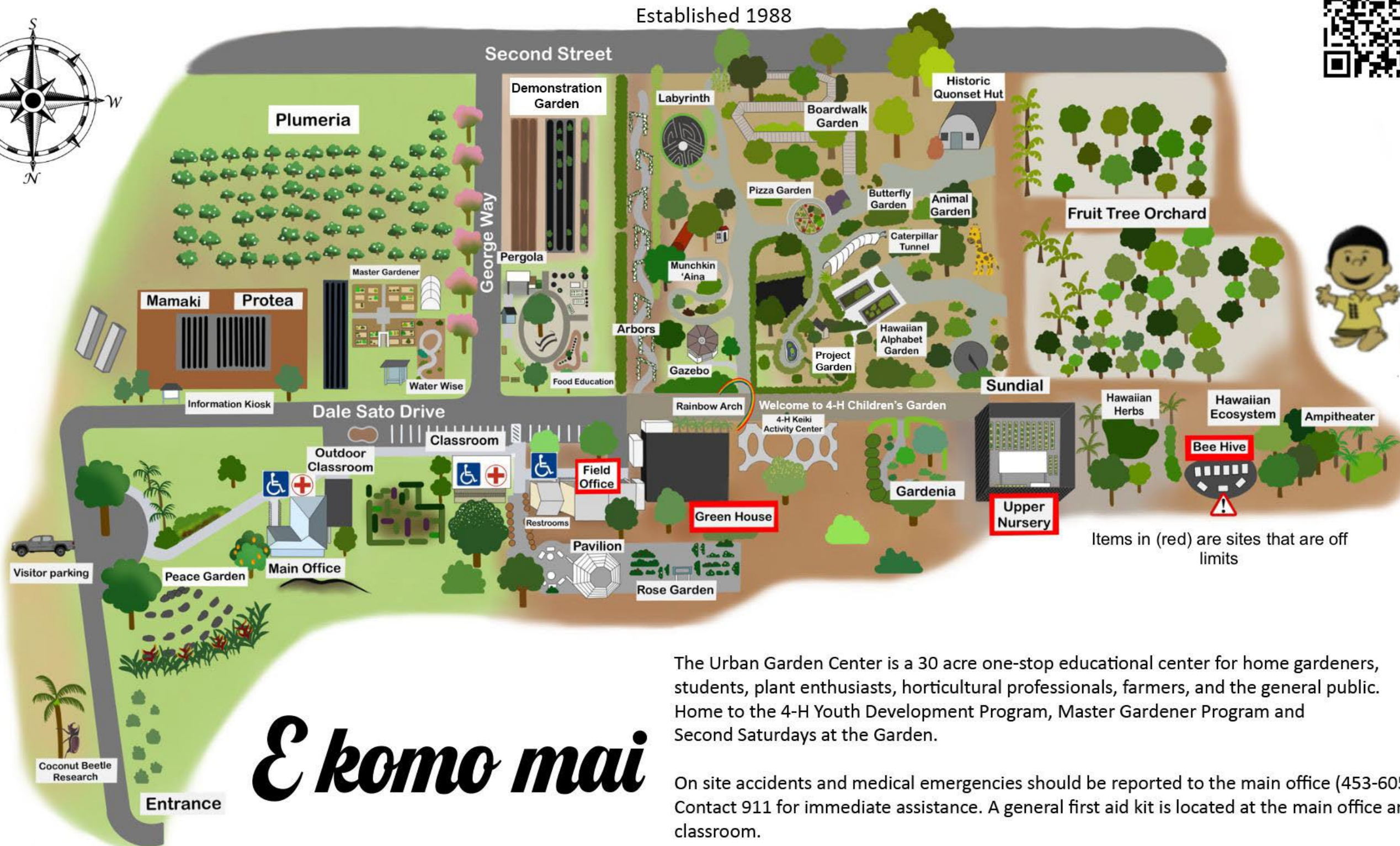

Visitor badge must be worn and visible at all times.

UGC is a smoke-free environment.

Do not pick flowers, foliage, fruits on the trees or on the ground.

Parents-please supervise your children at all times. No removing garden displays.

Protect against mosquitos; cover up with loose clothing and/or wear repellent.

Comfortable, closed-toe walking shoes are recommended for all garden areas.

Animals are not permitted, with the exception of service animals.

Bicycles, skateboards, or sports equipment are not allowed on the grounds.

No radios or musical instruments.

Be mindful of your surroundings. Look before you cross the street.

Do not feed the wildlife.
